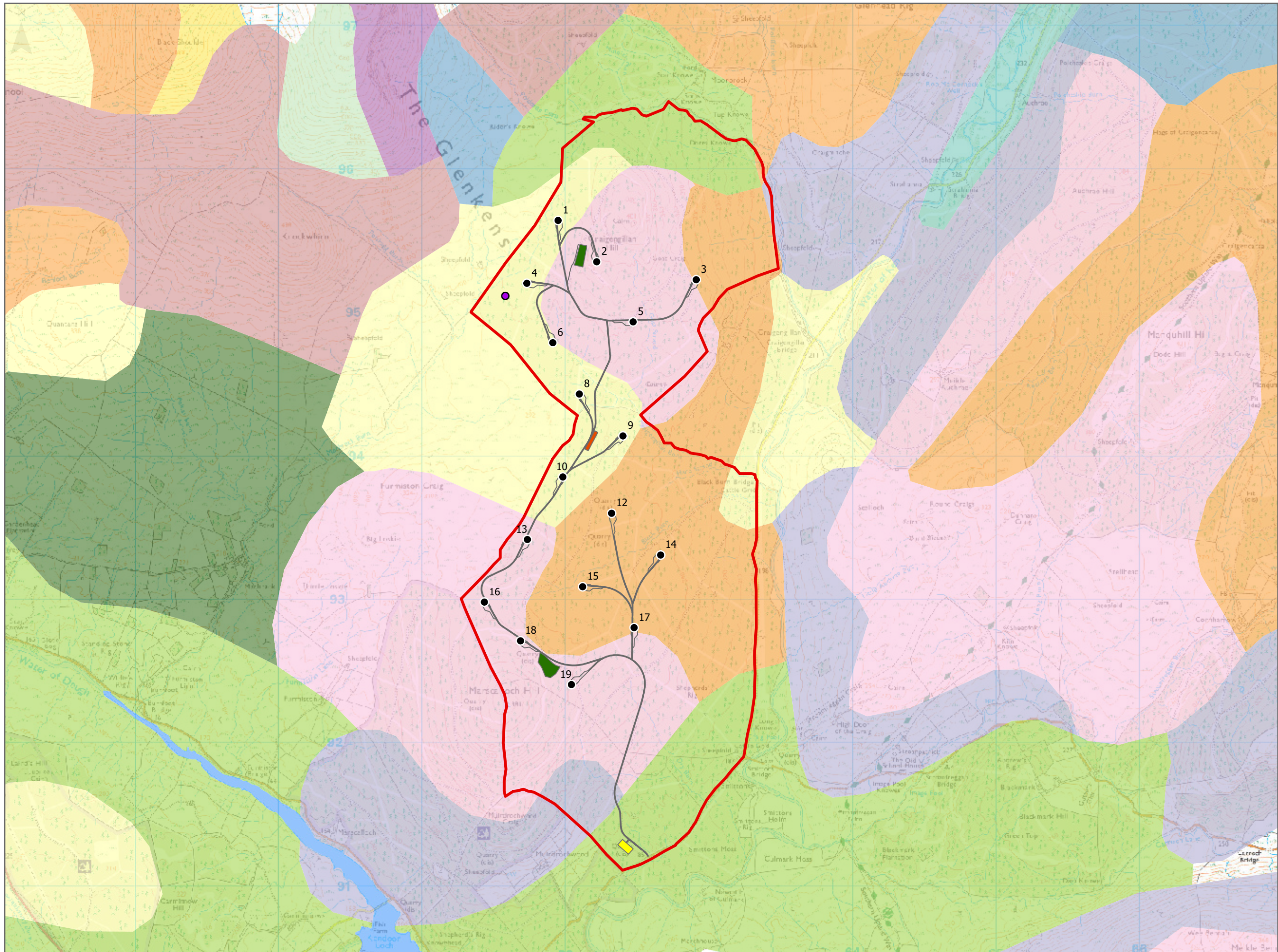


Figure 12.3: National Soils of Scotland
