NEXT STEPS



We will take into account the feedback we receive from our public consultation process as we refine our proposal and work towards finalising the Proposed Varied Development. We hope to submit the Section 36 application for the Proposed Varied Development to The Scottish Government Energy Consents Unit by May 2025.

An EIA Report including all the results from the surveys will be submitted with the formal application to the Energy Consents Unit. All the submitted documents will be uploaded to our website: www.shepherdsrigwindfarm.co.uk under 'Downloads'.

If you would like to receive a USB stick containing all the application documents or a hard copy of the Non-Technical Summary (NTS) (a summary of the EIA Report), please request this in the 'Voice your opinion' comment form available at the reception desk. The USB sticks and the NTS are provided free of charge for as long as stock last.

Professional bodies in the fields of ecology, aviation, noise, landscape, cultural heritage, transport etc. will be formally consulted on the application.
